Make-up Assignment for Week 31/32/33

I understand that access to technology and other resources has not been equal for all of you. For those reasons, I also understand it is possible that you missed some of our Zoom meetings for Week 31/32/33 and the notebook assignments. If you did not turn in the notebook vocabulary and assignments from Week 31/32/33, I am offering students an opportunity to replace those grades with an **alternative** assignment. - 2) How is Mandela's story about standing up for equal rights relevant to the current struggles and problems that we are experiencing in our own modern age today? You can talk about racism, segregation, COVID-19, the differences between "rights" and "responsibilities," etc.
